New autism treatment center preps for open house

An autism treatment center that opened in Carmel in 2002 is taking its first step outside the Indianapolis area — to Lafayette.

Ribbon-cutting ceremonies were held Monday afternoon for Little Star Center, which is open for business in the Cascada Business Park. The event was sponsored by Greater Lafayette Commerce.

"When we were looking for a second location, we kept hearing, 'Lafayette, Lafayette.' We did two community interest meetings and found there was a lot of need," said Mary Rosswurm, Little Star Center executive director. "The response has been overwhelming."

With 10 employees, and plans to double that number, the non-profit center has a maximum capacity of 12 learners. It already is serving children that range in age from 2 to 9.
