

Matrix finds new home in Cascada Business Park

A resource in the community since 1978, Matrix Pregnancy Resource Center has moved its Lafayette offices to Cascada Business Park.

Using donations and volunteers, Matrix PRC offers alternative options for women during pre- and post-pregnancy — all at no cost to the client.

Greater Lafayette Commerce sponsored ribbon-cutting ceremonies Tuesday to celebrate the new, larger site.

"We're so happy to be in this location. We couldn't do it without our volunteers," said Melissa McAtee, executive director. "This has been a long road."

Services offered by Matrix PRC include pregnancy testing, financial assistance for medical prescriptions and prenatal care, maternity and baby clothes, doctor referrals and confidential counseling, which includes post-abortion and prenatal.

Relocating to Cascada Business Park puts the organization in the proximity of a growing number of medical offices that also have moved to the east side of Lafayette.

"We're trying to reach out to the community," McAtee said. "We're fully funded by donors. That's what keeps us going."
